## **MESSAGE**

Eph. 4:15 I Tim 4:2 Mk. 16:20 Speak the truth in love; present truth, and life giving.

Message balanced, scriptural, doctrinally sound and spiritually right.

God confirms His Word - not person, pride or reputation.

## **MATURITY**

Jas. 3:17 Gal. 5:22 I Cor. 13

I Tim. 3:6

Attitude right; mature in human relations; heavenly wisdom. Fruit of spirit, Christ like character, dependable, steadfast. Not childish, Eph. 4:14, Heb 5:14, Biblically knowledgeable and mature; not a novice.
